AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #1720 REGULATING MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC IN THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD AND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 232 THEREOF ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, TO PROVIDE FOR EMPLOYEE METERED PARKING PERMITS

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough to make more intelligent use of existing Borough parking resources to increase the availability of convenient parking for customers and clients of Haddonfield businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department, the Parking and Access Committee and the Partnership for Haddonfield recommended a pilot program intended to increase the availability of on-street parking in the business district, particularly on Kings Highway, by providing an incentive for employees of businesses to park in the Borough parking lots in the rear of the businesses rather than at meters on the streets; and

WHEREAS, the pilot program has been conducted since October 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, it is now recommended that this pilot program be permanently integrated into Ordinance #1720 regulating traffic motor vehicle traffic and Chapter 232 entitled Vehicles and Traffic to include employee metered parking permits.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Haddonfield, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I:

Article XVII entitled Metered Parking #1720 regulating motor vehicle traffic in the Borough of Haddonfield, also known as §232-32 entitled Metered parking, is hereby amended to include the following, amendments are shown in bold:

H. Employee metered parking permit program.

- (1) **All vehicles parked in the above lots and the unit block of N. Haddon Avenue on the east side by Friends Cemetery in metered spaces shall be identified by use of a special permit issued by the Borough of Haddonfield, or one of its agents so authorized by the Borough, with the exception of the North Haddon lot.**

- (2) All permits are to be displayed in the front windshield in plain view.**
- (3) Each permit may be registered to more than one (1) vehicle so that it is transferable between those vehicles so registered.**
- (4) All persons being granted an Employee Metered Parking Permit shall pay the sum of \$40 per month.**
- (5) Eligibility, limit on number of permits issued.**
 - (a) A maximum of twenty-five (25) permits will be issued monthly.**
 - (b) No more than five (5) permits may be issued to employees and/or owners of any single business.**
 - (c) Only employees and owners of businesses on Kings Highway, S. Haddon Avenue, the first block of N. Haddon Avenue, Tanner street and Mechanic Street shall be eligible to purchase such permits**

SECTION II:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies only.

SECTION III:

If any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining sections and provisions shall, notwithstanding such holding, remain and be in full force and effect.

SECTION IV:

This ordinance shall be in effect upon passage and publication according to law.
